

# PERSONAL PAITY Protect your personal info from Phill

## Use Strong Passwords and Multi-Factor

Make sure your accounts have complex, unique passwords (a mix of letters, numbers, and symbols) and change them regularly. Enable multi-factor authentication for an added layer of security.

#### **Monitor Accounts**

Frequently check accounts that use your personal information for any unusual or unauthorized activity. Set up email or text alerts for every transaction, withdrawal, or login to check for any suspicious activity.

#### **Use Secure Networks**

Only use trusted, updated devices with antivirus software to access your personal information. Avoid using public wi-fi when accessing accounts with personal information.

### **Storing Details**

Don't store personal information like passwords or account numbers on your phone or computer unless encrypted. Always log out of accounts after accessing personal data, especially on shared or public computers.

#### **Beware of Scams**

Be cautious of unsolicited emails, texts, or phone calls asking for your personal details. Always verify the source before responding. When accessing websites, the URL should start with "https://".
